



BASSQUATCH™

What is it?

The Sasquatch™ has been one of my best selling pedals from the beginning. With it's massive tone and unmatched versatility, it really stands out in the world of fuzz. When I originally designed the Sasquatch™, I made sure it worked equally well for bass players as well as guitar players. Even with this equal voicing, I've had bass players ask if they could have a Sasquatch™ all their own. With that in mind I've created the all new, voiced-for-bass, Bassquatch™. It has the same massive fuzz tone and versatility of the original Sasquatch™ but has been enhanced to have a more massive low end and an aggressiveness that really shines on a bass and kills it with drop-tuned guitars.

How does it work?

Check to see if your Bassquatch™ came with a 9 Volt battery. If for some reason it didn't, make sure to use an alkaline battery or just use the DC power jack.

Important: Only use a 9 Volt, 200mA, negative tip DC adaptor like the Boss PSA 120.

At first glance the controls may not seem to make much sense. Here's a breakdown of what they do...

Find Him = Turns the effect on

Howl = Volume

Growl = Fuzz

Hungry = Bass cut

Full = Original, bass boost

Make Him Mad = Engages the freakout mode

Anger = Amount of freakout

Enter = You plug your guitar into here

Exit = Well, just guess...

"Howl" and "Growl" are pretty self explanatory after you start tweaking them. When you want to "Make Him Mad" make sure you have your "Howl" turned all the way up, then start turning the "Anger" knob until you have a nice balance of fuzz and noise. If you turn the "Anger" knob all the way up, you can control the pitch of the feedback with the volume, tone and switch on your guitar. You'll have hours of fun irritating anyone in the vicinity.

Note: You can only control the "Make Him Mad" freak out mode with the controls on your guitar or bass if your instrument is plugged directly into the Bassquatch. Any pedal that is before the Bassquatch in the signal chain will override this control.

Note for bass players: To get the most out of your Bassquatch, be sure to use a bass with passive electronics.

What if it breaks?

All Tortuga Effects have a **Three Year Warranty**. I want you to be confident in the fact that your pedal will always work, so if you have any problems with it ("problems" do not include dropping it, backing over it with your truck or dropping it and backing over it with your truck) please contact an authorized Tortuga Effects dealer or just contact me directly and I'll get it taken care of.
