What is it?

The Neptune™ has all the slosh and pulse of that classic ‘vibe tone without sucking out your midrange. Because of this, you don’t ‘disappear’ in the mix when you turn it on. It still has all the depth and color as the original rotating speaker simulators but it actually cuts through on lead tones too. The Neptune™ also has two sets of depth and rate controls that can be footswitched between for added versatility on stage.

How does it work?

Check to see if your Neptune came with a 9 Volt battery. If for some reason it didn’t, make sure to use an alkaline battery or just use the DC power jack.

Important: Only use a 9 Volt, negative tip DC adaptor like the Boss PSA 120.

At first glance the controls may not seem to make much sense. Here’s a breakdown of what they do...

Obey = Turns the effect on

Depth I = Depth control for channel one

Slosh I = Rate control for channel one

Depth II = Depth control for channel two

Slosh II = Rate control for channel two

I or II = Switches between the two channels

Dive = Plug your guitar into this

Surface = Out to your amp

‘Depth’ and ‘Slosh’ are pretty self explanatory after you start tweaking them. Try setting the first channel with a low ‘Depth’ and a faster ‘Slosh’ for a pulsing rotating speaker effect. Then set the second channel with a higher ‘Depth’ and a slower ‘Slosh’ for some big, Hendrix style warmth. Then use the ‘I or II’ footswitch to switch between them. Cool huh?

What if it breaks?

All Tortuga Effects have a **Three Year Warranty**. I want you to be confident in the fact that your pedal will always work, so if you have any problems with it (“problems” do not include dropping it, backing over it with your truck or dropping it and backing over it with your truck) please contact an authorized Tortuga Effects dealer or just contact me directly and I’ll get it taken care of.
