



STANDARD ISSUE PHASER

What is it?

The Standard Issue Phaser is based on the classic MXR Phase 90. It has been modified to have less of that nasally, upper midrange that you would usually associate with a modern phaser pedal. The current version Standard Issue Phaser has also been enhanced for bass guitars.

How does it work?

Check to see if your Standard Issue Phaser came with a 9 Volt battery. If for some reason it didn't, make sure to use an alkaline battery or just use the negative tip DC power jack.

Important: Only use a 9 Volt, negative tip DC adaptor like the Boss PSA 120.

At first glance the controls may not seem to make much sense. Here's a breakdown of what they do...

Engage = Turns the effect on

Force = Depth

Width = Rate

Mode = Switches between the two sets of controls ("Kill" and "Stun")

In = Duh

Out = Double duh

"Force" and "Width" are pretty self explanatory after you start tweaking them. The "Kill" and "Stun" controls are identical, but they allow you to set up two completely different phaser sounds at the push of a button. Try setting the "Force" at 3 o'clock and the "Width" at 12 o'clock on the "Stun" mode for a nice rotating speaker effect. Then turn the "Force" and "Width" on the "Kill" side all the way up to, well, kill people with your tone. Push the "Mode" switch to switch between them. Cool, huh?

What if it breaks?

All Tortuga Effects have a **Three Year Warranty**. I want you to be confident in the fact that your pedal will always work, so if you have any problems with it ("problems" do not include dropping it, backing over it with your truck or dropping it and backing over it with your truck) please contact an authorized Tortuga Effects dealer or just contact me directly and I'll get it taken care of.
